Todd County 4-H Talk Meet (Speeches & Demos)

The County 4-H Talk Meet will take place this spring on Thursday, April 20th at Elkton Baptist Church. Any 4-H youth may enter a speech and/or demonstration in the contest either through their classroom teacher or by calling the 4-H office to sign up. Public speaking is a great skill to learn and practice at an early age. If you would like to enter in the County 4-H Talk Meet, sign up before April 14th by submitting your speech or demonstration title to Imccuist@uky.edu. Junior speeches (age 9-14 years) must be between 3-5 minutes long. Senior speeches (age 15-19) must be 5-7 minutes long. Members may also enter a 4-H demonstration, which is a "how to" speech using props, posters, visuals, etc. Call or email the 4-H office for a complete list of demonstration categories. Two member team demonstrations are allowed. Participants in the county event will receive a 4-H Talk Meet t-shirt just for participating. Division winners will receive a trophy and move onto the Area 4-H Communications Contest Event set for May 11th in Hopkins County.

4-H Shooting Sports Coming this Spring



The Todd County 4-H Shooting Sports Club will start up this spring with an organizational meeting at the first practice in April (date to be announced). Youth between the ages of 9 and 18 interested in shooting trap, air and 22 pistol, .22 rifle, and/or archery should attend the organizational meeting with at least 1 parent or guardian. The Shooting Sports season runs April through Sep-

tember with practices held on Thursdays from 5:30-7:30 p.m. at the gun club between Elkton and Trenton. There are area shoots held through out the summer and the grand finale state shoot will be held mid September, 2023. Come on out and get involved in a great 4-H club! Eligible youth must be 9 as of Jan. 1, 2023. Spring coaches certification is coming up in March. Volunteers, sign up at the 4-H office.
