Todd County's camp week is <u>July 10th - 14th, 2023</u>. Camp application forms are included in this newsletter and will be handed out in mid-March to all 3rd - 8th graders at school too. The fee to attend this 5 day camp is \$**290.00** which covers transportation, housing, meals, classes,

recreation and much more. A \$50 (non-refundable) down payment is required to reserve your spot. **Partial 4-H camp scholarships are available to those campers in need**. For those applying for financial assistance—an additional form must be turned in along with a **\$50 down payment. All forms and the downpayments are due May 22nd (**last day of school)! 4-H Teens who are in the

9th - 12th grade must apply at the 4-H office to go as a 4-H Teen Counselor. Applications must be turned in by May 22nd to be considered. Fees for teens to attend are \$150 this year. Adults are needed to attend camp too. Please let the 4-H office know if you would like to serve as an adult camp counselor this year so we can begin the necessary paperwork to serve as a volunteer at 4-H Camp!

THE 4-H TALK MEET

The County 4-H Talk Meet will be in person this year on <u>April</u> <u>20th</u> during the school day, so anyone between the ages of 9 and 19 may sign up to present a speech and/or demonstration. Sign ups are due to the 4-H office by **April 14th.** If you would like to enter in the County 4-H Talk Meet, sign up through the 4-H office or with your teacher before the deadline. Junior speeches (age 9-14 years) must be between 3-5 minutes long. Senior speeches (age 15-19) must be 5-7 minutes long. Members may also enter a 4-H demonstration, which is a "how to" speech using props, 3 posters, visuals, etc. (5-15 min.) Call the 4-H office for a complete list of demonstration categories. If you won your classroom contest, you will be registered by your teacher! County winners will go on to compete at area on **May 6th** in Hopkins County.





4-H HORSE CLUB

The 4-H Horse Club is gearing up this spring with educational clinics and show preparations. The next meeting will be held on <u>March 7th</u> at the Christian County Extension Expo (behind the Christian County 4-H office) from 6-8 p.m. Any youth interested in horses is invited to get involved in this club if you are between the ages of 9 and 19 as of Jan. 1st of the current year. You don't have to own a horse to get involved in the 4-H Horse Club. At the Tuesday night meeting, FFA teachers Shayla Berry and Aaron Stallions will be providing lessons on hoof care and barrel racing pointers. After the lessons, 4-H'ers will have time to ride and play some fun horse games. Helmets are required to ride. Information about a <u>4-H Horse Camp coming April 20-22 in Bowling Green</u>.
