The fee to attend this 5 day camp is \$290.00 which covers transportation, housing, meals, classes, recreation and much more. A \$50 (non-refundable) down payment is required to reserve your spot. **Partial 4-H camp scholarships are** available to those campers in need. For those applying for financial assis-

tance—an additional form must be turned in along with a \$50 down payment. All forms and the downpayments are due

May 22nd! Families with more than 1 child attending may apply for a sibling discount of \$50 per sibling. 4-H Teens who are in the 9th - 12th grade must apply at the 4-H office to go as a 4-H Teen Counselor and be members of the 4-H Teen Council. Applications must be turned in by May 22nd to be considered. Fees for teens to attend are \$150 this year.
